Albert WOOD was born at Huddersffield, Yorkshire in 1899 the son of Arthur and Alice WOOD nee STOREY who were married 30/07/1892 at St. John the Baptist, Kirkheaton, Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, Beech Street, Pellon Lane, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 11 In the 1901 census the family were living at 20, Upper Bank End, Dalton, Huddersfield, Yorkshire.. He was aged 1

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, LocpmptiveDept. at Sowerby Bridge as a Labourer

He enlisted in the Northumberland Fusiliers at Halifax, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 May 1918 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
