***Personal History***

*Albert WOOD was born at Huddersfield, Yorkshire in 1899 the son of Arthur and Alice WOOD nee STOREY who were married 30/07/1892 at St. John the Baptist, Kirkheaton, Yorkshire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, Beech Street, Pellon Lane, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 11*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 20, Upper Bank End, Dalton, Huddersfield, Yorkshire.. He was aged 1*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, LocpmptiveDept. at Sowerby Bridge as a Labourer*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Northumberland Fusiliers at Halifax, Yorkshire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 May 1918 aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
