Joseph Alfred WOOLLEN was born at North Petherton, Somerset in 1893 the son of James and Harriet WOOLLEN.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Baguley Fold, Newton Heath, Manchester,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Electrical Instrument Apprentice.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Church Road, North Petherton, Somerset,. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Newton Heath as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 April 1918 aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
