Personal History

Samuel WORRALL was born at Warrington, Lancashire in 1896 the son of William and Emma WORRALL nee CROMPTON who were married 1883 at Salford Ascension, Salford, Lancashire. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 47, Franklin Street, Witton, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Cotton Weaver.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, Lune Street, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Lower Darwen as a Cleaner

He enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 8 May 1916 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
