***Personal History***

*Thomas Sutton WRIGHT was born at Southport, Lancashire in 1896 the son of James and Ellen WRIGHT nee SUTTON who were married 1892 at Ormskirk Register Office or Registrar Attended.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 29, Moss Lane, Southport, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Gardener (Jobbing).*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 72. Old Parl Lane, Southport, Lancashire,. He was aged 4*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Kew Gardens (Southport) as a Joint Clerk*

***Service History***

*He was living at Southport, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at the same place.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 17 August 1916 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
