## Personal History

Richard BOND was born at Colne, Lancashire on 1896? the son of Walter and Mary Jane BOND nee MAWDSLEY who were married 1887 at Preston Register Office or Registrar Attended.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 2, Gibfield Road, Colne. He was aged 5.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Chain Horse Youth

## Service History

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Nelson, Lancashire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 22 December 1915. His last known address was Nelson, Gordon Road, 7 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 July 1916

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
