He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Preston. Lancashire. on 2 September 1914 and embarked for France on 25 September 1915. His last known address was Preston, Lostock Hall, Luptons Terrace. 3

He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 May 1916 aged 20
