Personal History

William YOUNG was born at Wesr Derby, Liverpool, Lancashire the son of Jonathan and Emma YOUNG nee JONATHAN who were married 30/09/1872 at St. Peter, Liverpool, Lancashire. His mother died in 1919. He was a married man. His wife's name was Florence YOUNG (maiden name not known) Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Liverpool as a Collector

Service History

He was living at Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the South Lancashire Regiment at Seaforth, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 25 January 1915.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 March 1918

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
