Personal History

John Hankinson BRENNAN was born at North Meols, Southport in 1892 the son of John and Hannah BRENNAN nee HANKINSON who were married 1889 at St. Luke, Southport.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 10, Palmerston Road, Southport,. He was aged d 18 with the occupation of Office Boy in Solicitors Office.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 101 Newton Street, Southport,. He was aged d 8 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Southport as a Battery Attendant

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Army Medical Corps at Lydd, Kent. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 31 December 1915. His last known address was Southport, Palmerstton Road, 10 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of disease on 18 September 1916 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
