Personal History

Harry HAIGH was born at Halifax, Yorkshire in 1897 the son of Edwin and Jane Ellen HAIGH nee TAYLOR. His father died in 1907. His mother died in 1907.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 6, Thotnton Terace, King's Cross, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 18, Walnut Street, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Sowerby Bridge as a Cleaner

He enlisted in the Royal Marine Light Infantry. He is recorded as Buried at Sea on 31 May 1916 aged 19
