*Herbert HARRISON was born at Goole, Yorkshire the son of Henry and Elizabeth Ellen HARRISON nee STROUD who were married 1892 at St. James, Hull. His father died on .*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 20 September 1915. His last known address was Goole, Weatherall Street, 127 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Died on 16 November 1918 aged 24*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
