Personal History

Robert LEIGH was born at Horwich, Lancahire in 1892 the son of Joseph and Emily LEIGH nee WHEELER who were married 13/10/1876 at St. Thomas, Ardwick, Manchester. His father died in 1919. His mother died in 1919.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Core Maker

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Engineers. and embarked for France on 8 October 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Mary Street, 45 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 26 February 1919 in Home aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
