Personal History

Thomas WALKDEN was born at Wigan, Lancashire in 1877 the son of Thomas and Elizabeth WALKDEN nee CRITCHLEY who were married 1865 at All Saints, Wigan, Lancashire. His father died in 1889. His mother died in 1889.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 28, Cross Street, Wigan,. He was aged 33 with the occupation of Engineers Pattern Maker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 12, Second Avenue, Wigan, Lancashire. He was aged 23 with the occupation of Engineers Pattern Maker.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Elizabeth WALKDEN (nee LINNEY) They married at St. Thomas, Wigan, Lancashire on 14 March 1905. They had children: Lily b.1903, Frank b.1905, James Leslie b. 1908 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich
