

Private Albert Edward WOOD

4031 A' Comp. 2nd/8th Battalion Sherwood Foresters Died of Wounds 17 May 1916 aged 18

Personal History

Albert Edward WOOD was born at Southwell, Nottinghamshire in 1898 the son of William and Emma WOOD nee GRESSWELL who were married 1891 at Newark, Nottinghamshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Woodbine Terrace, New Balderton, Newark, Nottinghamshire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Errand Boy.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Little Pontom, Grantham,. He was aged 3
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at New Balderton, Newark when he enlisted in the Sherwood Foresters at Newark, Nottinghamshire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 17 May 1916 in Dublin aged 18
