*Died of Wounds 17 May 1916 aged 18*

*Not named on Victoria Station War Memorial*

***Personal History***

*Albert Edward WOOD was born at Southwell, Nottinghamshire in 1898 the son of William and Emma WOOD nee GRESSWELL who were married 1891 at Newark, Nottinghamshire.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Woodbine Terrace, New Balderton, Newark, Nottinghamshire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Errand Boy.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at Little Pontom, Grantham,. He was aged 3*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Labourer*

***Service History***

*He was living at New Balderton, Newark when he enlisted in the Sherwood Foresters at Newark, Nottinghamshire.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 17 May 1916 in Dublin aged 18*
