## Personal History

Fred BOOCOCK was born at Todmorden in 1889 the son of James and Emma BOOCOCK nee POWELL who were married 1876 at Todmorden.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 5, Myrtle Street, Todmorden,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Blacksmiths Striker.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Annie Boocock BOOCOCK (nee RUSHTON) They married at (Place unknown) on 29 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent Of The Line Dept. at Tomorden as a Porter

## Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 5 May 1915. His last known address was Todmorden, Back Brook Street, 17 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 6 September 1917 aged 29

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
