Personal History

John Ralston BOOTH was born at Huddersfield, Yorkshire in 1898 the son of Frederick William and Isabella BOOTH nee RALSTON who were married 1894 at Australia.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 15, Brook Grain Hill, Rastrick,. He was aged d 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 2, Rosemary Lane, Rastrick,. He was aged 2 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Train Booker

Service History

He was living at Rastrick when he enlisted in the Cameronians Scottish Rifles at Cleckheaton, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 1 October 1915. His last known address was Rastrick, Brook Grain Hill, 15 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 6 March 1916 aged 17 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
