Personal History

George Thomas BOOTHMAN was born at Rochdale, Lancashire in 1892 the son of Thomas and May Hannah BOOTHMAN nee LEE who were married 1893 at St. Chad, Rochdale.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Mill Farm, Rawcliffe, Goole,. He was aged 18

In the 1901 census the family were living at Farm House, Rawcliffe, Goole,. He was aged 8

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Signaller

Service History

He enlisted in the Irish Guards at Goole, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 August 1918 aged 26

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
