Personal History

Percival Frederick BOUGHEY was born at Cristleton, Cheshire on 20 January 1888 the son of John and Elizabrth BOUGHEY nee WALKER who were married 1872 at Our Lady & St. Nicholas & St. Anne Liverpool. In the 1911 census the family were living at Road Side Christleton, Nr. Chester,. He was aged d 23 with the occupation of Insurance Agent.

In the 1891 census the family were living at Road Side, Cristleton, Nr. Chester,. He was aged 3

He was a married man. His wife's name was Sarah Elizabeth BOUGHEY (nee ROBERTS) They married at St. Paul, Chester on 16 May 1910

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company

He was living at Chester, Cheshire when he enlisted in the Royal Army Service Corps at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died on 3 November 1918 in 42nd Casulty Clearing Station aged 30

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
