Personal History

Fred Walton BOWERS was born at Wakefield, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Frederick and Clarissa BOWERS nee WALTON who were married 1874 at St. Peters, Horbury.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Mark Street, Thornes Lane, Wakefield,. He was aged d 16 with the occupation of Train Booker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Church Street, (Union Square), Wakefield,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Machine Gun Corps at Wakefield, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 4 October 1917 in France or Belgium aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
