Albert Mitchell BOWKER was born at Oswaltwistle in 1899 the son of Fred and Mary Elizabeth BOWKER nee MITCHELL who were married 1897 at Immanuel Church, Oswaldtwistle.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Cleaner

He was living at Oswaltwistle when he enlisted in the London Regiment (Royal Fusiliers) at Accrington. He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 2 May 1918 aged 19 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
