*Albert Mitchell BOWKER was born at Oswaltwistle in 1899 the son of Fred and Mary Elizabeth BOWKER nee MITCHELL who were married 1897 at Immanuel Church, Oswaltdwistle.*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Cleaner*

***Service History***

*He was living at Oswaltwistle when he enlisted in the London Regiment (Royal Fusiliers) at Accrington.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 2 May 1918 aged 19*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
