***Personal History***

*Joseph BOWKER was born at Leeds, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of Henry and Ann Maria BOWKER nee FOSTER who were married 23/07/1893 at All Saints, Batley.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 25, Ellery Street, Leeds,. He was aged 5  
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Leeds, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 20 May 1915. His last known address was Leeds, Ellery Street, 25 (1901 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 5 November 1915 aged 20*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
