Personal History

Percy Pochin BRADFORD was born at Eccles, Salford in 1892 the son of Henry Inkerman and Briget (Delia) BRADFORD nee WHELAN who were married 1879 at Salford Registry Office or Registrar Attended. In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, Marvel Street, Patricroft, Eccles,. He was aged 8. Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Dublin Fusiliers at Salford, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 17 July 1917 aged 25 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
