George Henry BRADSHAW was born at Formby, Southport, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Peter James and Mary Ellen BRADSHAW nee MAWDSLEY who were married 1891 at Ormskirk Register Office or Registrar Attended.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 34, Cable Street, Formby,. He was aged d 17 with the occupation of Lamp Lighter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 18, Cable Street, Formby.. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

Service History

He was living at Formby, Southport, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Cheshire Regiment at the same place. on 26 November 1915

He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 October 1917 aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
