### ***Personal History***

*Joseph George BRANDISH was born at Salford, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Joseph George and Sarah Jane BRANDISH nee CROFT.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Lizzie BRANDISH (nee BANCROFT) They married at St. Thomsas, Pendleton on 31 March 1905*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Agecroft as a Cleaner*

### ***Service History***

*He was living at Rochdale, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Connaught Rangers at Salford, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 17 December 1915. His last known address was Rochdale, Freehold, Harris Street, 34 (CWGC).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 November 1917 aged 24*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
