Personal History

John William BRENNAN was born at Warrington, Lancashire on 1893? the son of Michael and Annie BRENNAN.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, Caroline Street, Lower Broughton,. He was aged d 18 with the occupation of Railway Clerk Goods Dept.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 7, Short Street, Salfore,. He was aged 8

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Salford as a Porter

Service History

He was living at Lower Broughton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Royal Rifles (Rifle Brigade) at Manchester, Lancashire. on 2 September 1914 and embarked for France on 6 March 1914. His last known address was Manchester, Lower Broughton, Caroline Street, 52 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 26 April 1915 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
