Personal History

Irvine BRITTON was born at Nelson, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Johnny and Amelia BRITTON nee JONES who were married 1888 at Burnley Register Office or Registrar Attended.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 59, Hibson Road, Nelson, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Carter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 5, Every Street, Nelson, Lancashire,. He was aged 7
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers
Dept. at Nelson as an Extra Carter

Service History

He was living at Nelson, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at the same place. on 21 July 1915 and embarked for Asiatic on 25 October 1915. His last known address was Nelson, Hobson Road, 59 (Attestation).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 9 April 1916 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
