Personal History

John Edmund BROADHEAD was born at Goole, Yorkshire in 1885 the son of Martin and Rebecca BROADHEAD nee HILLARY who were married 01/08/1885 at Goole Yorkshire.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 9. William Street, Hook Road, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 25 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 10 St. John's Terrace, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 In the 1891 census the family were living at 5, Wesley Square, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Goole Steam Shipping at Goole as a Labouer

Service History

He enlisted in the Lobour Corps at London. and embarked for France on 19 December 1914. His last known address was Goole, George Street, 26 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of disease on 9 October 1917 aged 32

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
