Personal History

Charles Rhodes BROOKS was born at Manchester, Lancashire.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Alice BROOKS (maiden name not known)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Engineers Dept. at Bury (East Lancashire) as a Platelayer

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Salford, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 5 May 1915.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 17 August 1915 in Gallipoli

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
