*Donald BROWN was born at Portsmouth, Hampshire on 1892? the son of John and Alice May? BROWN. Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Engineers Dept. at Accrington as a Platelayer*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Coldstream Guards at Accrington, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 26 November 1914.*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 27 July 1918 in 3rd Field Ambulance - France aged 26*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star*
