Personal History

Harry Clarence BULL was born at Wakefield, Yorkshire in 1898 the son of Alfred George and Margaret Ruth BULL nee CLARK. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 35, Hardy Croft, Peterson's Road, Wakefield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 2, and Shop, Kimberley Street, Sandal Magna, Wakefield,. He was aged 2

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Wakefield, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 April 1918 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
