***Personal History***

*John BURCHILL was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of James and Zillah BURCHILL nee RICHARDSON who were married 1893 at Dewsbury.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, Beresford Street, Oakenshaw, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Train Booker.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 13, New Bridge Lane, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Northumberland Fusiliers at Bradford, Yorkshire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 March 1918 in France aged 22*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal*
