Personal History

John BURCHILL was born at Bradford, Yorkshire in 1895 the son of James and Zillah BURCHILL nee RICHARDSON who were married 1893 at Dewsbury.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, Beresford Street, Oakenshaw, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Railway Train Booker.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 13, New Bridge Lane, Bradford, Yorkshire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Northumberland Fusiliers at Bradford, Yorkshire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 21 March 1918 in France aged 22 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
