Personal History

William Thomas BURGESS was born at Bridlington, Yorkshire in 1896 the son of Richard and Ann BURGESS nee RAWSON who were married 1896 at St. Oswalda, Famborough. His father died in 1914. His mother died in 1914.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 16, Dickenson Street. East Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Factory Hand.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 51, West Street, Hindlethorpe, Bridlington,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Labourer

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lacashire Regiment at Horwich, Preston, Lancashire. on 29 January 1916 He is recorded as Killed in action on 28 July 1917 aged 21 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
