Personal History

Norris BURLEY was born at Oldham, Lancashire in 1897 the son of William and Elizabeth Alice BURLEY nee HOLDEN who were married 17/05/1891 at St. Peter, Oldham, Lancashire. His father died in 1907. His mother died in 1907.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Henshaws Bluecoat School, Oldham Edge, Oldham,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Inmate.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 51, Silver Street, Oldham, Lancashire,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Manager Dept, at Oldham as an Extra Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the Border Regiment. and embarked for France on 26 November 1914. His last known address was Oldham, Oldham Edge, Henshaws Bluecoat School, Inmate (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 6 February 1916 aged 18

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
