Personal History

Patrick William BURNS was born at Dublin, Ireland in 1881.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 1, Cloth Hall Yard, Bank Street, Warrington,. He was aged 30 with the occupation of Labourer.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Rebecca BURNS (nee DOWNING) They married at Toxteth Park Register Office or Registrar Attended on 28 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Night Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the South Lancashire Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 5 December 1914. His last known address was Liverpool, Sefton Park, Aspen Grove, 96 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died at home on 1 May 1918 in Northern Genaral Hospital aged 37

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
