Personal History

George BURTON was born at Blackburn, Lancashire in 1889 the son of John and Sarah Jane BURTON. His father died in 1929. His mother died in 1929.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 326, Bolton Road, Ewood, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Groom Blouse Manufacturers.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 5. Minden Street, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 11

In the 1891 census the family were living at 108, Sing Brook, Blackburn, Lancashire,. He was aged 1

He was a married man. His wife's name was Alice BURTON (nee FLETCHER) They married at St. Peter, Aintree on 31 March 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Aintree as a Fireman

Service History

He was living at Aintree, Liverpool when he enlisted in the Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 3 May 1915. His last known address was Liverpool, Aintree, Sydney Street, 9 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 20 November 1917 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
