Personal History

Frederick Edward CALLOW was born at Dalton, Lancashire on 1895? the son of Thomas and Margaret CALLOW nee BAWDEN who were married 1892 at Kendal, Westmorland. His mother died in 1943.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3, Ann Street, Blackpool, Lancashire. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Water Engineer/Fitter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 3, Ann Street, Blackpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 9?

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Wyre as an Extra Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own (Royal Lancaster) Regiment at Blackpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 14 February 1915. His last known address was Blackpool, Manchester Road, 27 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 July 1915 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
