Personal History

Henry Dickson APPLEYARD was born at Goole, Yorkshire the son of Stephen C. APPLEYARD.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Louisa APPLEYARD (maiden name not known)

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Goole Steam Shipping at Goole as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 22 July 1915. His last known address was Goole, Richarfd Cooper St., 35 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 5 September 1916 in Heilly Station, France aged 32

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
