Personal History

Edwin Stanley CAMPBELL was born at Swinton, Lancashire in 1893 the son of Edwin and Elizabeth CAMPBELL nee COUSINS who were married 1885 at St. John, Pendlebury. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 48, Park Street, Swinton,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 11, Park Street, Swinton,. He was aged 7

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Audit Accountant Dept. at Head Office as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Liverpool, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 28 November 1915. His last known address was Swinton, Park Steet, 48 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 22 August 1916 aged 22

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
