Personal History

John Edwin CARTER was born at (Hulme) Tonge, Lancashire on 1894? the son of John Thomas and Hannah Marie CARTER nee WADE who were married 01/08/1891 at Holy Trinity, Hulme. His father died in 1940. His mother died in 1940.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 381, Bury Road, Lancashire,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 381, Bury Road, Lancashire,. He was aged 7 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Bolton as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Army Medical Corps at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for Egypt on 11 August 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Tongue Park Avenue, 71 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died at sea on 13 August 1915 in Lost in Royal Edward aged 23

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
