Personal History

Arthur CATHERALL was born at Manchester, Lancashire in 1892 the son of Andrew Atha and Ada CATHERALL nee HARRISON who were married 08/08/1885 at St. Jude's , Edge Hill, Liverpool. His father died in 1961. His mother died in 1961.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 66, Church Street, Newton Heath, Manchester -. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Cloth Packer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 20, Thorpe Street, Newton Heath, Manchester,. He was aged 8 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Newton Heath as a Timekeeper

He enlisted in the The King's (Liverpool) Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 3 May 1917 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
