Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Line Dept. at Hrad Office as a Clerk

He enlisted in the Royal Enginneers at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 11 May 1915. His last known address was Manchester, Heaton Park, Russell Street, 3 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 25 October 1916 aged 31

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
