Personal History

Stanley CHAPMAN was born at Ashton-on-Mersey, Cheshire in 1896 the son of Thomas James and Mary Jane CHAPMAN nee EDWARDS who were married 1895 at Christ Church, Salford.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 3. Sefton Street, Southport, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Solicitors Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Beech Grove, Ashton upon Mersey, Altrincham,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Liverpool as a Clerk

He was living at Southport, Lancashire when he enlisted in the The King's (Liverpool) Regiment at the same place.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 30 November 1917 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
