Personal History

Jospeh Arthur CHARLTON was born at Rochdale, Lancashire in 1897 the son of John and Sarah CHARLTON nee STUART who were married 1896 at St. Chad, Rochdale. His father died in 1968. His mother died in 1968.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 70, Durham Street, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Cotton Ring Doffer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 32, Morefield Terrace, Rochdale,. He was aged 3 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Joint Clerk

He is recorded as Killed in action aged 20
