Personal History

Joseph CHILVERS was born at Beccles, Suffolk in 1862 the son of Joseph Bobbitt and Sarah CHILVERS nee BLOWER who were married 1853 at Beccles, Suffolk. His father died in 1891. His mother died in 1891.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Emily's Address - 48, Percy Street, Goole - Joseph'. He was aged About 49

In the 1901 census the family were living at Emily's Address - 48, Percy Street, Goole - Joseph'. He was aged About 39

In the 1891 census the family were living at 9, Waplar Road, Lowestoft?. He was aged 28 with the occupation of Sea Mariner.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Emilt Sarah Louise CHILVERS (nee GILES) They married at Parish Church, Goole on 1 March 1896. They had children: Elizabeth Alice b. 1897, Joseph b. 1899, Emily b. 1900, Edward b.1903, Sydney b. 1905

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Steward

He enlisted in the Mercantile Marine.

He is recorded as Died at sea on 7 April 1918 aged 56
