Personal History

Jesse CHIPCHASE was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1897 the son of John Joseph and Mary Alice CHIPCHASE nee HEAP who were married 1895 at St. George, Bolton. His father died in 1931. His mother died in 1931.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 13, elbourne Grovem Howich, Lancasahire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Appretice Fitter, Railway.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 19, Worsley \road, East Ham Romford,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as an Apprentice

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for Egypt on 25 September 1914. His last known address was Bolton, Horwich, Lower Brayley. Brayley Avenue, 12 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 31 October 1917 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
