Edgar Samuel CLARKE was born at Pickmere, Cheshire - Soldiers Died in 1894 the son of Samuel and Elizabeth CLARKE nee CARTER who were married 1888 at St. Wilfred, Davenham.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Shipperbottom Farm. Walmersley, Bury,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Farm Hand.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Pickmere Farm, Pickmere,. He was aged 6
Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at
Bury as a Cleaner

He enlisted in the Grenadier Guards at Bury, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 September 1915 aged 21 He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
