Personal History

James Wallace Rennie CLEGG was born at Oldham, Lancashire in 1894 the son of James and Jane CLEGG nee RENNIE who were married 1880 at St. Thomas, Weneth, Oldham. His mother died in 1950.

In the 1911 census the family were living at Denshaw House, Denshaw, Delph, Near Oldham,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Coyyon Dyer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 67, Windsor Road, Oldham,. He was aged 6

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

Service History

He was living at Oldham, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Army Service Corps at Royton, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died on 23 October 1918 in 49th General Hospital, Salonica aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
